WELCOME TO THEOBALDS ROAD

A Grade II listed Georgian masterpiece in the heart of London's Midtown, lovingly restored and brought into the 21st century to join the Boutique Collection.

12-18 Theobalds Road is a thrilling workplace, blending stunning original features that radiate historical character with ultra-modern design touches. You can't help but feel the building's charm as you walk around, with wonderful natural light throughout, excellent views whichever way you look and a beautiful courtyard to unwind in. Situated in an illustrious area of London with plenty of transport links nearby, it's an outstanding workplace fit for boutique businesses.

Theobalds Road is immersed in the history of London. This building dates back to c1750 and was a miraculous survivor of relentless bombing which destroyed the surrounding buildings during The Blitz. Interestingly, Theobalds Road sits above the site of the original Kingsway tram station which was a popular commuter route from 1906 to 1952. The hidden station has been featured in several Hollywood blockbusters including The Avengers and is now open to visitors.


Stepping further back into history, this area was famously inhabited by Charles Dickens who lived and wrote on nearby Doughty Street, so you can walk in his footsteps on your daily commute.




LOCATION
